

Project Overview – Track

- 20-metre-wide turf track
- 17-metre-wide sand/fibre training track (200mm deep)
- 6-metre-wide Ambulance track
- Appropriate drainage across all tracks
- Fully irrigated over the 3 tracks (including the realigned jog track)
- New pump house/filtration system (located infield)
- Need to run additional power
- New lighting
- Triax cabling
- Relocation of Steward Towers
- Relocation of Big Screen
- Consideration around Brittain Rd and the land swap impact
- Consideration around the 1675m start (Stewards Request allow for a greater run-in to the first bend)
- Dam building consider water table levels






Project Overview – Stalls

- 150 + stalls (currently 165)
- Wash bays
- Swabbing boxes
- Permanent cover over stalls
- Consider heat escape and ventilation
- Create separation between owner & horse
- Distance to public buildings currently 21 metres likely update to 10 metres as part of LAP
- Drainage Horse waste separation
- Integration connection with horse float area
- Asphalt stalls and horse float area
- Integration and connection with course proper and

training tracks

- Integration and connection with mounting yard
- Addition of water catchment options tanks
- Lighting/electrical connection
- Toilets
- Viewing Deck
- Check in Control
- Teas & Coffee area
- Traffic management from horse float park (including gates & fence line)
- Further consultation with industry will occur before the design is finalised

Track Consolidation Period	3-6 months

- Construction is scheduled to commence following the running of the 2020 Bunbury Cup.
- The project is expected to take approximately 18 months, during which the Bunbury Turf Club will not host race meetings.
- Training is expected to resume after approximately 6-9 months. RWWA will consult with industry regarding alternative training options during this period.
- The re-allocation of races will occur as part of the normal 2020/21 race programming process.
